Water bottles can be filled up from the taps in the classroom or else at designated taps around the school. Our helpful cleaning staff are on site every day cleaning high touch areas over and over again. Hand-sanitiser is available in many locations across the school. Our teachers and staff have been following-up with extra lessons and times to ensure hand-washing is occurring throughout the day.
